

# Town of Angier Residents

Waste Industries looks forward to providing your new curbside recycling. Your scheduled day of pick up will be the same as your current trash collection day, but will occur on an every other week basis beginning on the week of July 12<sup>th</sup>. This means the first day of recycling service will be on July 14<sup>th</sup> for residents getting trash service on Wednesday's, July 15<sup>th</sup> for residents getting trash service on Thursday's, and July 16<sup>th</sup> for residents getting trash service on Fridays. Recycle service will occur every other week thereafter from these start dates.

## RECYCLING MADE EASY

Now you can conveniently recycle aluminum, steel food cans, glass food & beverage containers, newspapers and cardboard. Simply place the items in the 65 gallon cart provided.

### ▪ GLASS

Accepted: All glass food & beverage containers; any color

NOT Accepted: Plate glass, ceramic materials, or any glass that is not a food beverage container.

**How to recycle:** remove metal tops and rinse all containers. Paper labels do not need to be removed.

### ▪ ALUMINUM, TIN & STEEL CANS

Accepted: Any aluminum, steel, tin food and beverage container. Aluminum foil and pie plates.

NOT Accepted: Metal Oil cans or metal containers for non-food products

**How to recycle:** Empty and rinse all cans

### ▪ NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, AND WHITE PAPER

Accepted: Newspaper & all the inserts, magazines, catalogs, white paper including junk mail.

NOT Accepted: Books and Phone Books

**How to recycle:** Place loose in container

### ▪ PLASTIC BOTTLES AND SOFT PLASTIC RINGS

Accepted: Plastic #1 thru #5, as long as the mouth of the container is smaller than the base. Plastic six pack rings.

NOT Accepted: Plastic containers that have contained antifreeze or other hazardous waste.

**How to recycle:** Rinse all containers

### ▪ GABLE TOP CONTAINERS AND ASEPTIC BOXES

Accepted: Milk, Juice, and Detergent Cartons; Milk and Juice Drink Boxes

NOT Accepted: Milk or Juice Drink Sacks

**How to recycle:** Empty and Rinse all containers, remove straws from drink boxes

### ▪ PAPERBOARD, CHIPBOARD, SBS BOARD AND PAPER TUBES

Accepted: Cereal, pasta, toothpaste, beer boxes. Tubes from paper towels and toilet paper

NOT Accepted: Waxed boxes

**How to recycle:** Flatten all boxes

### ▪ CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Accepted: Cardboard in pieces and flattened that fit in cart

NOT Accepted: Pizza Boxes or cardboard contaminated with food, Styrofoam

**How to recycle:** Boxes must be completely flattened, all packing material must be removed including glued or loose Styrofoam

\*\*Please make sure your containers are to the curb the night before your designated service day. Should you have any questions, please call Waste Industries, Inc. at (919) 662-7100. Please remember that trash carts must be removed from curbside by 7:00 p.m. on day of pick-up. Thank you!
