Volunteer job site tasks include framing, roofing, painting, landscaping, and installing siding, windows, doors, flooring and more. We accept volunteers as individuals or groups. The ReStore is a place that sells gently used furniture, appliances, doors, building materials and many other household items that are donated by the community and are tax deductable. Proceeds from the store are a source of funding to build for Habitat locally. By doing jobs that paid staff would normally do, you allow us to give even more money to Habitat to build affordable housing in Harnett County.
